Provision – Academy Visit

- The team from Provision, our strategic planning consultant, will return the week of April 15th to meet with members of the Muskegon Heights Community. The SPC has identified a broad representative set of individuals and groups from across the MHPSAS community for these meetings.
- Provision will host Idea Wall sessions in the High School Library. MHPSAS scholars, faculty, and staff will have the opportunity to post their thoughts about important strategic

planning questions and respond to comments from others. This is a great opportunity to brainstorm ideas with your friends and colleagues. Please be sure to try and make an effort to stop by and share your thoughts by April 18th!

Upcoming Events

- Provision has administered an anonymous survey to all MHPSAS scholars, faculty, staff, alumni, board members, parents/guardians, and community members. The survey includes open-ended questions that will give you an additional opportunity to share your thoughts. The survey can be found on our Strategic Planning webpage and will be available until **Friday, March 29th**.
- Provision will also organize and review all the information from the community input from meetings held, ideas shared in meetings with Provision during campus visits, Idea Wall input and survey results.
- Provision will present planning themes that emerged from these inputs with the SPC.
- The Board will review the Needs Assessment Report at their next regular board meeting on **Tuesday, April 16th**.
- The SPC and other community members will then meet with Provision to further develop the themes into a draft planning document which will also be reviewed by the community before it is finalized and becomes the new Strategic Plan. Our goal is to present a three-year Strategic Plan to the Board of Directors for approval at their June meeting.
